If you seek to use a study abroad for your experiential learning, be sure to get it approved before you enroll; not all study abroad experiences are suitable for experiential learning.

- 2. Ensure that the project/internship supervisor sends an evaluation of their efforts to the Associate Department Head for Undergraduate Affairs (dstauffe@vt.edu).
- 3. Evaluate their internship experience and send the evaluation to the Associate Department Head for Undergraduate Affairs (dstauffe@vt.edu).
